
# What is the Parenting Puzzle?

Workshop : Understanding Children's Behaviour, Listening and Communicating, Praise and Encouragement

**Workshop 2:** Praise and Guidance vs. Criticism, Child-led Play, and Positive Moments

Workshop 3: Boundaries and Parenting Styles, Time to Calm Down, Dealing with Stress and Conflict

Workshop 4: Choices and Consequences, Behaviour to Ignore, Putting the Puzzle Together, Looking after Ourselves

#### Practical information

There are four 2-hour sessions with a tea and coffee break

10-20 parents are invited and there are two trained group leaders

partners are welcome and it's also fine to come on your own or with another relative or friend

Some groups provide a creche; check with group leaders beforehand

you need to come to all four workshops: they fit together like a puzzle

you will be provided with a copy of The Parenting Puzzle book to accompany the workshops.

### 3 THE HAPPY HUB - CHOLSEY

Hello,

We are called The Happy Hub and we are based in **Cholsey pavilion**, we are open from 9.00am - 11.30am. We are a children/family centre primarily for 0-5yrs old although we do open in the school holidays and siblings up to the age of 8yrs are welcome (parents/carers have to stay with their child). We benefit being right next to a park which is visible from the hub. We work on donations and ask for £3 per child when visiting.

I have attached a copy of our timetable.

We have a regular pre-walkers/Crawlers group every Thursday morning and we do 'Soft Play Fridays.'

We have a few things coming up in the hub, a Halloween party on the 31st October (this will be bookable via Eventbrite).

We also have a 'Christmas drumming Session with Andy and his African drums' on Wednesday 17th December as well as a Santa's grotto (date tbc).

For future reference we do something called 'Fun in the Park' in August of the Summer holidays and there's a different activity everyday, its a mix of getting people in to run the session eh. Gymnastics, Farms2Ewe, Zoolab etc. and us also doing activities such as our Teddy Bears picnic.
